An act amending the UCO Student Association Bylaws; providing for clarification of membership procedure; to go into effect upon approval.

WHEREAS, A need for clarification of procedure has arisen, and

- WHEREAS, UCOSA must ensure a clear understanding of the governing documents to best serve the organization and student body, and
- WHEREAS, Each senator deserves a fair and equal treatment, and
- WHEREAS, Senators shall work together to solve problems as possible and Legislative leadership shall be able to step in to assist senators in personal development and conflict resolution, and
- WHEREAS, Some issues that come before the UCOSA Congress shall require extra consideration, now therefore

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE UCO STUDENT ASSOCIATION

- Section 1. The Bylaws, Chapter Two, Subsection VI shall be amended to read as follows.
  - VI. In the case that a Senator has a grievance against another Senator, including Congressional Leadership, legislation shall be drafted, which outlines the grievances and whether the Senator shall be removed from their leadership position or removed from Congress. The legislation must be submitted to the Chair of the UCOSA Congress and must be reviewed through the Internal Affairs Committee. Prior to review by the Committee, the Legislative Branch's Leadership and UCOSA advisor must meet with both the Senator with a grievance and the Senator the legislation is being filed against. This legislation must be passed with a two-thirds vote of the UCO Student Congress. In the case of the legislation passing, the Senator with grievances will step down from their leadership position or resign.

Section 5. This legislation shall go into effect immediately after passage and approval.
