BE IT ENACTED BY THE UCO STUDENT ASSOCIATION

- Section 1. UCOSA urges the University of Central Oklahoma to start up a program that would allow for students to submit an application to further allocate funds to students for printing on campus. This program will allocate funds and be based on need.
- Section 2. This rule will be enforced at the beginning of the Fall semester of 2022.
