## AS INTRODUCED

An act amending the Congressional Bylaws of the UCO Student Association to require bifurcation of financial appropriations to different organizations in congressional legislation; providing codification, and providing an effective date.

- WHEREAS, The UCOSA Ways and Means committee exists to address all matters concerning the expenditure or appropriation of student funds; and
- WHEREAS, Aside from their Annual Budget, the Ways and Means committee passes numerous pieces of legislation throughout the year to allocate additional funds to organizations; and
- WHEREAS, Including multiple appropriations of funds in a single piece of legislation disallows Senators to have the ability to vote on individual allocations; and
- WHEREAS, Bifurcating financial appropriations by organization will provide further transparency for the votes of UCOSA Senators; now therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE UCO STUDENT ASSOCIATION

- Section 1. This act shall be known as the Appropriation Bifurcation Act
- Section 2. A new section shall be added to Chapter Seven of the UCO Student Association Congressional Bylaws, to read as follows:
  - VIII. Financial Resolutions passed by the Ways and Means committee providing for Sponsorship Funding shall be bifurcated between organizations, providing funds to no more than one organization per financial resolution.
